## *From Your Golf Course Superintendent, Duane VanEtten*

*We are in the process of tree trimming, wood line cleaning along hazard line and removing roots in play areas. We have replaced some of our irrigation controllers during the month of February and will continue until completed. Resurfacing of bridge entries and exits have been started and will continue until completed along with replacing bridge boards in need. Liquid fertilizer will be applied to tees and fairways monthly throughout the winter months. Continued spot spraying weeds with a post emergent herbicide every month along with roundup spraying of tree rings. Our second pre emergent weed control application and grub control application was completed in March. Granular fertilization was applied the first week of March. In order to preserve our fairway conditions throughout the winter months I encourage everyone to obey the 90 degree rule throughout the golf course. New driving range accessories and convenience station for one tee have been completed thanks to Gary Gunnels. They look outstanding. I hope everyone that played in the Blazer had a great time, I know I did. Thanks to all that put the event together and to those who participated.*

*As always I will try to keep all of you informed with what we are doing on the golf course through my monthly newsletter articles. We always do our best to have the golf course in the best playing condition as we perform the necessary agronomic practices needed to promote healthy turf and the safety of our members.*
